PERSONAL DEVOTIONS

Thank you for choosing to **MEET GOD AND HIS SON!** Have you ever asked this question: Does God answer prayer? The answer is YES! God answers every prayer! However, His answer may not be your desired outcome but will cause you to turn to God respond to your prayer and meet your needs. Both God and Satan are in pursuit of your soul. **God will do whatever it takes** to get your attention. **Satan will do whatever it takes** to distract your attention away from God. **Satan will lie to you** distracting you away from God. **God will speak Truth to you** and use your circumstances, to draw you to Himself. Every action you take is based on what you believe. **BUT WHAT DO YOU BELIEVE???**

- **Who** will you believe? God or Satan?
- **What** is on your “To Do List” to get right with God?
- **When** will you spend time praying God’s Word?
- **Where** will you spend eternity?
- **Why** do you think it’s important to discern Satan’s lies from God’s Truth?
- **How** do you discern lies from Truth?
- **If** the laws of gravity apply to everyone, will God’s laws apply to you?

You may select how you respond to one Scripture each day. For instance, you may:

- Read, pause and wait a moment for God to inspire your written response.
- Simply copy the Scripture and highlight text that stands out to you personally.
- Write your prayer requests for relationships, family, health, finances, whatever!
- Illustrate something that comes to your mind.
- There are 30 Scripture passages – just one a day for a month to start your great habit.
- God will meet you right where you are as you read His Word and write a quick journal entry in Bible Bites.

Here is the test to find whether your mission on Earth is finished: If you’re alive, it isn’t. (Richard Bach)

<p>The earth is the Lord's, and everything in it. The world and all its people belong to him. <b><u><i>Psalms 24:1</i></u></b></p>	<p>Yet God has made everything beautiful for its own time. He has planted eternity in the human heart, but even so, people cannot see the whole scope of God's work from beginning to end. <b><u><i>Ecclesiastes 3:11</i></u></b></p>
<p>“The human heart is the most deceitful of all things, and desperately wicked. Who really knows how bad it is?” <b><u><i>Jeremiah 17:9</i></u></b> Haughty eyes, a proud heart, and evil actions are all sin. <b><u><i>Proverbs 21:4</i></u></b></p>	<p>. . . when people keep on sinning, it shows that they belong to the devil, who has been sinning since the beginning. But the Son of God came to destroy the works of the devil. <b><u><i>1 John 3:8</i></u></b></p>

<p>If we claim we have no sin, we are only fooling ourselves and not living in the truth. If we claim we have not sinned, we are calling God a liar and showing that his word has no place in our hearts. <b><u>1 John 1:8, 10</u></b> As the Scriptures say, “No one is righteous— not even one. No one is truly wise; no one is seeking God.” <b><u>Romans 3:10-11</u></b></p>	<p>Long ago the Lord said . . . I have loved you, my people, with an everlasting love. With unfailing love I have drawn you to myself. <b><u>Jeremiah 31:3</u></b> “I am the Lord, and I do not change” <b><u>Malachi 3:6</u></b></p>
<p>Everyone who sins is breaking God’s law, for all sin is contrary to the law of God. And you know that Jesus came to take away our sins, and there is no sin in him. <b><u>1 John 3:4-5</u></b> Remember, it is sin to know what you ought to do and then not do it. <b><u>James 4:17</u></b></p>	<p>Do not love this world nor the things it offers you, for when you love the world, you do not have the love of the Father in you. For the world offers only a craving for physical pleasure, a craving for everything we see, and pride in our achievements and possessions. These are not from the Father but are from this world. <b><u>1 John 2:15-16</u></b></p>

... God is light, and there is no darkness in him at all. So we are lying if we say we have fellowship with God but go on living in spiritual darkness; we are not practicing the truth. But if we are living in the light, as God is in the light, then we have fellowship with each other, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, cleanses us from all sin. **1 John 1:5-7**

For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard. Yet God, with undeserved kindness, declares that we are righteous. He did this through Christ Jesus when he freed us from the penalty for our sins. **Romans 3:23-24**

Jesus replied, "I tell you the truth, unless you are born again, you cannot see the Kingdom of God." **John 3:3**  
 "And you will perish, too, unless you repent of your sins and turn to God . . ." **Luke 13:3** For there is only one God and one Mediator who can reconcile God and humanity—the man Christ Jesus. He gave his life to purchase freedom for everyone. **1 Timothy 2:5-6**

"For God loved the world so much that he gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life. God sent his Son into the world not to judge the world, but to save the world through him." **John 3:16-17**

But God showed his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners. **Romans 5:8**  
 And just as each person is destined to die once and after that comes judgment, so also Christ died once for all time as a sacrifice to take away the sins of many people. **Hebrews 9:27-28**

I do not treat the grace of God as meaningless. For if keeping the law could make us right with God, then there was no need for Christ to die. **Galatians 2:21** For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the offering for our sin, so that we could be made right with God through Christ. **2 Corinthians 5:21**

For God in all his fullness was pleased to live in Christ, and through him God reconciled everything to himself. He made peace with everything in heaven and on earth by means of Christ's blood on the cross.  
**Colossians 1:19-20**

**"I tell you the truth, those who listen to my message and believe in God who sent me have eternal life. They will never be condemned for their sins, but they have already passed from death into life."** **John 5:24**

<p>The world's sin is that it refuses to believe in me.  <u><b>John 16:9</b></u> "Everyone who acknowledges me publicly here on earth, I will also acknowledge before my Father in heaven. But everyone who denies me here on earth, I will also deny before my Father in heaven."  <u><b>Matthew 10:32-33</b></u></p>	<p>"If you love me, obey my commandments. And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate, who will never leave you. He is the Holy Spirit, who leads into all truth. The world cannot receive him, because it isn't looking for him and doesn't recognize him. But you know him, because he lives with you now and later will be in you." <u><b>John 14:15-17</b></u></p>
<p>He never sinned, nor ever deceived anyone. He personally carried our sins in his body on the cross so that we can be dead to sin and live for what is right. By his wounds you are healed. <u><b>1 Peter 2:22, 24</b></u></p>	<p>He gave his life to free us from every kind of sin, to cleanse us, and to make us his very own people, totally committed to doing good deeds. <u><b>Titus 2:14</b></u></p>

And all of this is a gift from God, who brought us back to himself through Christ. And God has given us this task of reconciling people to him. For God was in Christ, reconciling the world to himself, no longer counting people's sins against them. And he gave us this wonderful message of reconciliation.

**2 Corinthians 5:18-19**

... 'There is forgiveness of sins for all who repent' . . .  
 "And now I will send the Holy Spirit, just as my Father promised." **Luke 24:47,49** This is a trustworthy saying, and everyone should accept it: "Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners". . . others will realize that they, too, can believe in him and receive eternal life. **1 Timothy 1:15-16**

"When God our Savior revealed his kindness and love, he saved us, not because of the righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He washed away our sins, giving us a new birth and new life through the Holy Spirit." **Titus 3:4-5**

"Sirs, what must I do to be saved?" They replied, "Believe in the Lord Jesus and you will be saved." **Acts 16:30-31** Now repent of your sins and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped away. **Acts 3:19**



For God says, “At just the right time, I heard you. On the day of salvation, I helped you.” Indeed, the “right time” is now. Today is the day of salvation.

And if there is no resurrection of the dead, then Christ has not been raised. And if Christ has not been raised, then your faith is useless and you are still guilty of your sins. **1 Corinthians 15:16-17**

My old self has been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me. So I live in this earthly body by trusting in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me. **Galatians 2:20**  
 “He generously poured out the Spirit upon us through Jesus Christ our Savior. Because of his grace he declared us righteous and gave us confidence that we will inherit eternal life.” **Titus 3:6-7**

I no longer count on my own righteousness through obeying the law; rather, I become righteous through faith in Christ. For God’s way of making us right with himself depends on faith. **Philippians 3:9** Because of Christ and our faith in him, we can now come boldly and confidently into God’s presence. **Ephesians 3:12**

“I am leaving you with a gift—peace of mind and heart. And the peace I give is a gift the world cannot give. So don’t be troubled or afraid.” **John 14:27**  
 But if we confess our sins to him, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness. **1 John 1:9**

God saved you by his grace when you believed. And you can’t take credit for this; it is a gift from God. Salvation is not a reward for the good things we have done, so none of us can boast about it. **Ephesians 2:8-9**

<p>. . . we can boldly enter heaven’s Most Holy Place because of the blood of Jesus. By his death, Jesus opened a new and life-giving way . . . let us go right into the presence of God with sincere hearts fully trusting him. For our guilty consciences have been sprinkled with Christ’s blood to make us clean, and our bodies have been washed with pure water.  <u><b>Hebrews 10:19-22</b></u></p>	<p>If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by confessing with your mouth that you are saved.  <u><b>Romans 10:9-10</b></u></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u><b>PRAYER OF SALVATION</b></u></p> <p>Jesus, I confess to You that I am a sinner and can do nothing on my own to enter Heaven and spend eternity with You. <p>Pay attention to and note below Satan’s distractions and attacks:  <b>Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil. And he will flee from you. James 4:7</b></p>

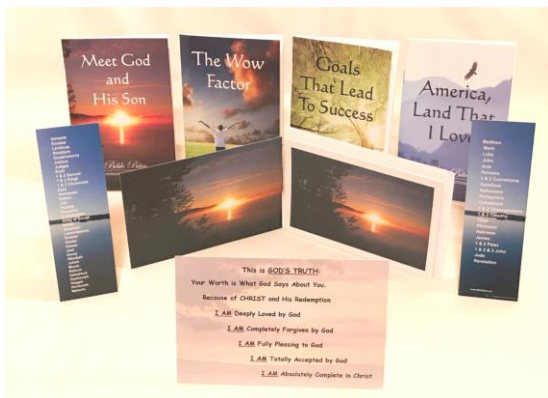
